Our Commitment To You

Your trainers will ensure that the welfare of the dog is paramount. No activity will be conducted which permits, encourages or develops aggression in a dog.

The training methods employed and advised will be consistent with the principles of kindness and fairness to both clients and dogs. Coercive or punitive techniques and equipment (check/choke chains, prong or spike collars, electric shock devices in any form, high frequency sound devices/discs that are designed to startle) will not be used.

The training techniques employed and advised, are from the application of scientifically based research and knowledge, which therefore result in the practice of non-compulsive methods.

Trainers will be alert to the differing levels of the experience of both owners and dogs and be courteous at all times.

At the start of each training course the importance of good behaviour, the socialisation of dogs and the theory of training, will be discussed. Advice will be given on choosing suitable collars, leads, identity disc and training equipment.

Owners will be reminded to carry some form of 'poop-scoop' and to remove fouling caused by their pets.

At every opportunity trainers will promote the wider aspects of responsible dog ownership.

Following each training session you will be given written guidance and "homework" for you to complete with your dog during the week.
